Residential Energy Upgrade Grants

Program Overview

The City of Perth recognises the importance of environmental sustainability and transitioning toward a resource efficient, climate-conscious, green city.

The Residential Energy Upgrade Grant program supports body corporates in residential strata-title buildings to undertake upgrades that will improve environmental performance of existing residential buildings and work towards net-zero emissions.

The grant supports upgrade projects that relate to common areas or provide communal benefit for residential occupants.

Key Dates

The City will accept applications for Residential Energy Upgrade Grants at any time, however decisions are made on a case-by-case basis in line with budget and strategic priorities. This grant operates as exhaustive funding and the City reserves the right to close the program once the available budget has been expended.

Applications open 1 November 2023

Application close 30 April 2024, 4pm AWST

Approved projects must be completed within 12 months of decision.

Funding Levels Available

The Residential Energy Upgrade Grant operates in three funding streams, with matched funding provided by the City.
